- Awards are open to:
 - students who are studying (or have studied) an NCTJ-accredited course entering work produced between 1 September 2009, and 31 July 2010 (coursework or work experience)
 - trainees with less than two years' employment experience, whether working towards the National Certificate Examination or those who have recently taken it, entering work produced between 1 September 2009 and 31 July 2010
- Every entry must be endorsed by a tutor or editor (signature required above) to confirm it is the entrant's own work
- Three** copies of each entry should be enclosed. This completed entry form and supporting statement must be attached to each copy
- All entries must be **posted** and received by the NCTJ by 5pm on 17 September 2010. Entries cannot be returned.
